- 1. Present: Chairman Jim Biggin; Maureen Biggin; John Cooper; Sue Fotheringham; Malcolm Green;
- 2. Apologies: David Barnett;
- **3.** Loss of WCRA name: following the formation of a company called "West Christchurch Residents Association Ltd" based in Ringwood by Dr Somerville-Ford and his threat to sue WCRA if it used that name again it was decided to change the name of WCRA to the Jumpers and St Catherine's Hill Residents Association.
- 4. Registration of new name: Jim Biggin was authorised to register the new name. (He subsequently confirmed that it had been submitted to the National Business Register LLP and had been registered as number 2298756)
- 5. New Constitution: the necessary changes to the constitution were ratified
- **6. Changes to website**: Jim Biggin confirmed that our webmaster Eileen had worked quickly to effect the initial required changes
- 7. Changes to documentation: Jim Biggin confirmed that the new renewal documents had been printed and delivered to Sue Fotheringham; other documentation had been ordered from the printers and would be delivered over the course of the next few days
- **8. Collections**: Sue Fotheringham confirmed that collectors had been told to stop collecting. Old documentation will be collected in and replaced with new documentation and new collectors badges
- 9. Logo: it was decided to pursue the creation of a logo to be registered to the new RA
- 10. Informing members: it was decided to inform all members, both e-mail and non-e-mail, as soon as possible
- **11. Legal advice**: a discussion of this topic revealed no matters of urgency on which legal advice was required. It was decided to do nothing now but to revisit the topic when necessary
- **12. HSBC and Teachers BS**: Jim Biggin was authorised to notify both organisations of the change of name once registration was confirmed
