- 3. In attendance: Alan Clarke
- 4. Minutes of last meeting: the minutes of the meeting of February 2019 were confirmed
- **5. Accounts 2019**: as at end February expenditure exceeded income by £533.97 and assets stood at £7,682.77. This is normal for this time of the year before the collecting of subs gets underway in May
- **6. Council Elections May 2019**: Sue Fotheringham and Jim Biggin outlined progress to date in preparing for the elections.
- **7. Spring 2019 Paper Newsletter**: Sue Fotheringham confirmed that these have been distributed to members.
- **8. AGM March 2019**: the committee agreed to present Alan Clarke as the latest member of the management committee
- **9. Local Authority Reorganization**: Jim Biggin reported steady progress including Council Tax harmonisation.
