- 1. Present: Chairman Jim Biggin; Maureen Biggin; Sue Fotheringham; Malcolm Green;
- 2. Apologies for absence: Eileen Lancaster;
- 3. Minutes of last meeting: the minutes of the meeting of March 2019 were confirmed
- **4. Alan Clarke**: the withdrawal of his application to join the committee by Alan Clarke was noted
- 5. Accounts 2019: as at end March expenditure exceeded income by £1,367.38 and assets stood at £6849.36. Whilst this is normal for this time of the year before the collecting of subs gets underway in May it has been exacerbated by spending on the Council elections. It was resolved that £500 should be transferred from Teachers BS to our HSBC current account
- **6. Subscription Rate 2019**: it was noted that the AGM had decided to keep the subscription rate at £1 per household
- **7. Council Elections May 2019**: Sue Fotheringham and Jim Biggin outlined progress to date in preparing for the elections.
- **8.** Hall on the Hill: Malcolm Green expanded upon his resignation as an associate on the Hall committee. Eileen Lancaster will retain our links with the Hall
- 9. Friends of St Catherine's Hill: Sue Fotheringham reported on the progress of the Management Plan. The committee was pleased to hear that Robin Harley has transferred from CBC to BCP and will retain responsibility for St Catherine's Hill. The report from The Gun Club was welcomed.
- **10. Maintenance of Website:** during Eileen Lancaster's absence maintenance has fallen behind and her imminent return in mid-April was welcomed
- **11. Book Swapping:** Malcolm Green has examined the site and considers the walkways too narrow to support a "book case" whilst still allowing prams, wheelchairs and mobility scooters appropriate access. He will talk to the resident.
