In these minutes: BCP=Bournemouth, Christchurch, Poole Unitary Authority; CTC = Christchurch Town Council; DUA=Dorset County Unitary Authority; DWP=Dorset Waste Partnership; PC=Parish Council; RA=Residents Association; SSSI=Site of Special Scientific Interest (Town Common and St Catherine's Hill for example)

- 1. Present: Chairman Jim Biggin; Maureen Biggin; Malcolm Green; Eileen Lancaster;
- 2. Apologies for absence: Sue Fotheringham;
- 3. Minutes of last meeting: the minutes of the meeting of June 2019 were confirmed
- 4. Accounts 2019: noted that £82 of subs had been banked. No other transactions.
- 5. Collection of subscriptions: Sue Fotheringham had reported no problems
- 6. CTC Council:
  - **6.1.** In a written submission Sue Fotheringham had reported on training she had received. She has been appointed to the Planning Committee but has not received the specialist training required to undertake this quasi-judicial role and is therefore rightly not yet fully participating.
  - **6.2.** Sue provided a note prepared by Robin Harley of BCP giving contact details for residents when confronted by anti-social behaviour, a fire on the Hill, etc. These details have been posted to our website
  - **6.3.** The resignation of the Highcliffe Council Town Clerk was noted and its potential impact upon the CTC Town Clerk
  - 6.4. Noted that CTC still has no website
- 7. BCP Council:
  - **7.1.** The council committees have started to function, and Malcolm Green confirmed that he will monitor the Planning Committee whilst Jim Biggin monitors the financial and strategic ones.
  - **7.2.** The Committee noted the plans announced to review several planning decisions taken by the previous Conservative administration and questioned the value of this exercise. They also wondered if looking backwards was all that the rainbow coalition could agree on rather than the far harder task of moving forward on an agreed front.

- 9. St Catherine's Hill: no major developments.
- 10. Website Maintenance: Eileen Lancaster reported no major issues
- 11. Recruitment to the Committee: Jim Biggin updated the committee on progress.
