How to recycle your Christmas tree



Come January, you can [recycle your real Christmas tree](#) to make compost. You can:

- Take it to your local [household recycling centre](#)
- Cut it up and put it in your (optional) [garden waste bin](#)
- Look for a local Christmas tree recycling scheme and contact them directly.

Extra recycling and rubbish this Christmas?



Most of us produce extra waste at Christmas. But remember, most of it can be recycled.

All **extra recycling** will be collected if placed in your own boxes.

We will also collect up to **two extra sacks** (any colour) of rubbish on your first [rubbish collection](#) of the New Year.
