Treasurers Report For The Financial Year To 31st December 2018

The accounts for the year have been completed, a copy of which has been circulated today. If anyone does not have a copy please contact me after the meeting and I will ensure that one is made available to you.

On the reverse side of the accounts the main items of expenditure have been analysed and you will see that Printing and Stationery has reduced dramatically during the year. This was a direct result of the enforced name change during 2017 and revising the format of the Member's Certificates.

Sundries have reduced during the year because during 2017 we incurred various costs relating to the change of name to ensure that the new name was protected in the future. These costs were non - recurring.

The costs of hiring the hall have increased during the year as we are no longer able to hold the monthly meetings in a private house.

The net result of all of these items was an increase in the "Fighting Fund" during the year of £540, leaving the total funds of the Association at the year-end of £8217.

The committee therefore recommend that the annual subscription remains at £ 1.00 per household for 2019.
