- **3.** Minutes of last meeting: The minutes of 3rd April 2013 were approved.
- 4. Treasurer's Report: David Barnett reported that as at 30th April we had funds of £6292.04 and had incurred anticipated losses year-to-date of £496.67. It was noted that 2013 subscriptions had started to arrive.
- 5. Collectors: Maureen Biggin reported that she had trained one new collector and had two more to do. Dreswick Close; Hurn Road; Katterns Close; and Old Barn Close collections had been completed
